Pastors

May 1 | PERSIAN SPEAKING WORLD

Praise God for Pastor Abedini and other Christians who have been released from Iranian prisons. Pray that those who remain imprisoned will find strength in Christ daily and be released soon.

May 2 | BRUNEI

Pray for pastors and church leaders involved in youth ministry in Brunei, as the law prohibits them from exposing children to religions other than Islam.

May 3 | COLOMBIA

Pray for peace and wisdom for Pastor Javier* and his family as they continue to receive death threats from a criminal gang, despite having moved several times.

May 4 | UZBEKISTAN

Pray that Jamshut*, pastor of a Protestant church, would be able to leave on an exit visa.

May 5 | NIGERIA

May 6 | YEMEN

Praise God that, despite the war, the gospel continues to spread as people who have left the country stay in contact with the friends they have had to leave behind.

May 7 | CAMEROON

Ask God for fruitful ministry to refugees and the internally displaced who have fled from Boko Haram.

May 8 | MYANMAR

Pray for Chin and Kachin Christians who have escaped across the border into China, that they would bring their anxiety to God and find peace and rest in Him.

May 9 | IRAQ

Pray that Iraqi Christians would be able to witness to God’s steadfast love and provision even when all has been lost by worldly standards.

May 10 | SOUTHERN PHILIPPINES

May 13 | SRI LANKA

Pray that Bibles, discipleship materials, classes, conferences, practical aid and persecution-preparedness trainings would all serve to strengthen God’s people in Sri Lanka.

May 14 | INDONESIA

Pray that Standing Strong Through the Storm seminars would be used by God to prepare His own for persecution, should it come their way.

Churches

May 15 | CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC

Praise God that Christians did not react violently to the burning of an Evangelical church, as was the hope of the Muslim extremist who set the blaze to create an opportunity for reprisal from Muslims.

May 16 | ALGERIA

Pray that church members and leaders will have wisdom and welcome for the Algerians who knock on their doors with questions about Christianity.

May 17 | BANGLADESH

As murders and death threats linked to radical Islam continue, pray that the Church in Bangladesh would have compassion towards their persecutors and show them Christ’s love.

May 18 | MALAYSIA

Pray that churches would feel convicted and called to reach out to vulnerable secret believers, despite the risk in doing so.

May 19 | NIGERIA

Pray for the Church in Maiduguri, located in battle-weary northeastern Nigeria. Pray that the gospel would be their anchor in a storm of physical hardship and spiritual struggle.

May 20 | SAUDI ARABIA

Praise God that His Church in Saudi Arabia is growing! Pray that they will be able to meet freely and safely.

May 21 | Libya

Pray for migrant churches that are salt and light to Libyans, especially as they are the only ones allowed to officially gather for worship.
