September 23 | EGYPT

September 25 | MYANMAR

Pray for Muslim Background Believers from the Sama tribe as Muslim, singular leaders target the group due to an increase of Christian activity.

September 27 | UZBEKISTAN

Pray for a family who is being targeted for preaching the gospel. They are facing persecution from authorities, neighbors and relatives.

September 28 | DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Pray for the families and communities of nine believers killed in suspected Islamist militant attacks.

September 29 | SYRIA

Pray that for believers in Syria who, because of conflict and persecution, have been reduced by two-thirds in the last five years.

September 30 | MALAYSIA

Pray God would draw His own to Himself in preparation for persecution from Malaysians who have joined the Islamic State.
